The Richard Nixon Foundation invites junior and senior undergraduates and graduate students interested in history, political science or museum studies to apply for its historical research internship program.

This 12-16 week internship offers students the opportunity to apply historical knowledge and familiarize themselves with the vast collection of primary historical materials within the holdings of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) located at the Richard Nixon Presidential Library and Museum.

Over the course of a semester, students will develop keen awareness of historical research principles and a greater understanding of civics through familiarizing themselves with practical knowledge of how the executive branch functionally operates.

Interns will also contribute to various Foundation departments, incorporating archival materials into research guides, marketing materials, social media content, and special exhibitions. This is a unique opportunity to engage directly with history and develop valuable research and analytical skills.
